Secondary School Place 2026 If your child is due to start secondary school in September 2026, please make sure that you complete the on-line application form by **12 noon on the 31st October 2025** via www.oldham.gov.uk/admissions (for Oldham residents). You must apply through your home address borough, regardless of where the secondary school is. If your child is attending an 'open event' during the school day, please inform the school office in advance so the absence can be authorised and recorded accordingly.

Make Every Day Count! Our average whole school attendance is currently **97.71%** giving us one of the highest scores in the borough. Thank you for helping us to promote a positive culture for attendance and punctuality and ensuring that your child comes to school on time, every day, unless they are too unwell.
